NSW BUDGET DELIVERS FOR ILLAWARRA AND SHOALHAVEN

The 2020-21 NSW Budget delivers major investment in a wide range of areas for the Illawarra-Shoalhaven region.

Key highlights from the Budget include:

HEALTH:

- **\$10.1 million** in 2020-21 (as part of a \$698.6 million project) for the new Shellharbour Hospital (State and Federal funded); and
- **\$4 million** in 2020-21 (as part of a \$438 million project) for the commencement of the Shoalhaven Hospital Redevelopment.

EDUCATION:

 Planning for a new school in South Nowra/Worrigee, and a major upgrade at Dapto Public School.

TRANSPORT:

- **\$148.2 million** in 2020-21 to continue construction of the Albion Park Rail bypass, Yallah to Oaks Flats, Princes Highway;
- **\$102.5 million** in 2020-21 to continue construction of the Berry to Bomaderry upgrade on the Princes Highway; and
- **\$5.8 million** in 2020-21 for the continued planning for the Kiama to Bomaderry Rail Capacity Increase.

PLANNING:

- **\$3.2 million** in 2020-21 (as part of a \$3.7 million project) to continue improvements to the Murramarang South Coast Walk; and
- **\$1.7 million** in 2020-21 (as part of a \$3.6 million project) to deliver new and upgrade quality social and affordable housing for Aboriginal communities in Bomaderry, Oaks Flats and Nowra.

REGIONAL NSW:

- **\$4.5 million** in 2020-21 (as part of a \$5.3 million project) for the Shoalhaven Sustainable Tourism Infrastructure Package;
- **\$3.2 million** in 2020-21 (as part of a \$6.5 million project) for the Killalea Multifunction Facility;
- **\$2.4 million** in 2020-21 (as part of a \$3 million project) for Employment Land Activation in the Shoalhaven Flinders Industrial Estate; and
- \$600,000 in 2020-21 (as part of a \$900,000 project) for the delivery of the Dunn Lewis Multi Purpose Auditorium.
